**Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> April - Unaffiliated Training Show**  
**Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> April - BSPS Classes and Unaffiliated Classes**

**Show Information:**

- DAY 1 - No height limit on ponies/horses, simply choose the height of fences that suits you. Also no age limits on riders.
- DAY 2 - Unaffiliated classes as well as BSPS Classes. Height and age limits on some classes. You do not need to be a member of BSPS to compete! BSPS Rules apply. This is perfect for competitors who have never done BSPS before, as you can have a go at unaffiliated and then try BSPS classes as well.
- *This is a BSPS Points Show for Area 1B. BSPS Affiliation number 144/19.*
  - No conformation marks on Day 1.
  - You may ride more than one pony/horse in the unaffiliated classes.
- Renowned course builder Graham Barclay who builds at The Royal Highland and many other HOYS and RI qualifiers so to jump round one of his tracks is a great opportunity!
- Greenlands has the most wonderful huge all weather outdoor arena which lends itself to building a superb course so you have a wealth of opportunities here.
- Stabling is available by contacting Greenlands directly (see the website) There is a Travelodge a mile away and a local pub. The café will be open during the day.
- DAY 1 - Training stakes and Style and Performance classes are £15 a class.
  - DAY 2 - Classes all £15.
- *Any rider competing both days will get a reduced rate of £12 per class.*
  - **Late entries will be £5 extra on the day - Cash only.**

    - Riding Hats to current standard
- Horse Riding is a risk sport, and you compete at your own risk, horses must be four years old and over.
- Any suitable bridles may be worn and handles on saddles in the Lead Rein are permitted
  - The Judge's decision is final.
    - You do not need to be a member of any society to compete.
- Horse Passports with evidence of flu vaccination within last 6 months must be shown to organisers.
- BSPS classes - please refer to BSPS Rule book 2019 regarding qualifying for Summer Championships.
- This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Black Country Saddles Best Rider - Rule 450 & 451. This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Classic Security (UK) Ltd Challenge - Rule 453. This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Summer Championships - Rule 448.
- This show is a qualifier for **NCPA Pony of the Year Show** in September. First and Second prizewinners in appropriate classes will qualify.

This Show is a qualifier and every horse & pony placed 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the BSPS Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. Qualification is for the Horse & Pony except for Adult/Young Handler classes, where the Handler qualifies. All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Show's website [www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com](http://www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com) where you will also

**Training Stakes - do a show straight after your jumping round.**

**Style and Performance - no show, judged purely on your jumping round.**

Class 1 Training Stakes - fences just above or on ground level (LR/off LR)

Class 2 Style and Performance - fences just above or on ground level (LR/off LR)

Class 3 Training Stakes - 35 cms (assistance allowed)

Class 4 Style and Performance - 40cms

Class 5 Training Stakes - 45 cms

Class 6 Style and Performance - 50cms

Class 7 Training Stakes - 60cms

Class 8 Style and Performance - 65 cms

Class 9 Training Stakes - 70 cms

Class 10 Style and Performance - 75cms

Class 11 Training Stakes - 80 cms

Class 12 Style and Performance - 90 cms

**DAY 2 CLASSES - Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> April**

**Judges: Mrs P Clifford and Mrs P. Stirling**

*In Training Stakes classes, you will do a very short show straight after your jumping round.*

Class 15 Tiny Tots Training Stakes, fences tiny. On or off the Lead rein.

Class 16 THE B.S.P.S. TINY TOTS STAKES. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st. January in the current year. Maximum height and spread for fences 40cms. Open to plaited or unplaited ponies.

Class 17 Beginners Training Stakes plaited/unplaited ponies fences approx 50cms.

**BEGINNERS CHAMPIONSHIP open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> from Classes 15, 16 and 17.**

Class 18 THE B.S.P.S. CRADLE STAKES. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 19 THE B.S.P.S. NURSERY STAKES. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

**BSPS MINI CHAMPIONSHIP open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> from Classes 18 and 19.**

**1<sup>st</sup> prize winners will qualify for the BSPS White Company 50<sup>th</sup> Year Golden Anniversary Mini WHP Champion of Champions.**

Class 20 Training Stakes for plaited/unplaited ponies fences approx 65cms.

Class 21 Training Stakes for plaited/unplaited ponies fences approx 75cms.

***\*The following classes are BSPS Mixed Height Classes. This means that you jump in the correct height (of pony) section. For classes 22 and 23 this will be 133cm, 143cm, 153cm and 158cm. For classes 24 and 25 this will be 122cm, 133cm, 143cm, and exc 143cm.\****

Class 22 THE B.S.P.S. MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE W.H.P/Intermediate W.H. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 158cms. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.  
(see rule 37) Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cms. or the Intermediate Section.

Class 23 THE B.S.P.S. MIXED HEIGHT OPEN W.H.P/Intermediate W.H. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 158cms. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.  
(see rule 37). Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cms. or the Intermediate Section.

Class 24 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND NOVICE WHP. MIXED HEIGHT. Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4yrs. old or over. Riders any age. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.

Class 25 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN WHP. MIXED HEIGHT. Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4yrs. old or over. Riders any age. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.

**(Class 22 - 25 may be split if entries warrant and Championships will be held)**

1<sup>st</sup> prize winners in classes 23 - 25 will qualify for the BSPS Binks Family 50<sup>th</sup> Year Golden Anniversary Show Champion of Champions.

Class 26 Novice Horse fences approx 80cms

Class 27 Open Horse fences approx 95/1m.
